## Checklist for creating learning outcomes

have i discussed my LOs with the program director, academic dean?
Have I considered how my course LOs contribute to the BBA or MSc program
LOs?
Have I compared my course LOs to other course LOs in the same semester?
Have I compared my course LOs to other courses in the same subject area in
preceding or following semesters?
Have I focused on outcomes, not processes, i.e., have I focused on what the
students are able to demonstrate rather than on what I have done in my
teaching?
Have I begun each outcome with a Bloom's taxonomy cognitive action verb?
Have I used only one Bloom's taxonomy cognitive action verb per learning
outcome?
Have I avoided terms like know, understand, learn, be familiar with, be
exposed to, be acquainted with, and be aware of?
Are my outcomes observable and measurable?
Are my outcomes capable of being assessed?
Have I included learning outcomes across the range of levels of Bloom's
Taxonomy?
Do all the outcomes fit within the aims and content of the module?
Have I the recommended number of outcomes (1-2 LOs per 15 contact
hours)?
Is it realistic for students to achieve the learning outcomes within the time and
resources available?
