#### HOW TO FIND ARTICLES

Start from the Databases page: <a href="https://library.glion.edu">https://library.glion.edu</a>

There are **three options** to search for articles:

1. Starting a global search in all databases directly from the main search bar on the top of the page:



2. Connecting individually to each Database. See "FAQ-Resources"



3. Starting a search with EBSCO Publication Finder, in the Databases list, with a journal title to search within the publication:





#### GLOBAL SEARCH WITH THE SEARCH BAR

On the results page, you will be able to refine your search.

Click on "All filters" to open the menu:





- "Full Text Only" for all the articles with full text access
- "Academic (Peer Reviewed)
   Journals" if you want to search
   for academic resources
- "Catalog Only" for only the physical book in the library collection
- "Published Date" for selecting published document from the past 12 months, 5 years, 10 years, etc.

 "Source Types", allows you to choose what type of resources you want to retrieve, e.g. select "Academic Journals" to retrieve only articles

Click on "Apply" to refresh your results with the new filter(s) you have selected

To know if the library holds a journal, go to the library website on the Databases tab and click on the database called "EBSCOhost Publication Finder":

#### Enter the name of the journal, e.g.:

The search result will display as follows:





The result shows in which database(s) you will be able to retrieve the full text.




Click on the database link to access the journal.

From this point you have 3 options:

So you can simply browse through the year and issue numbers on the right-hand side, e.g. 2023, Volume 28, Issue 8:


2. You have the exact title, and you can simply use the "Search within this publication" link and enter the title:



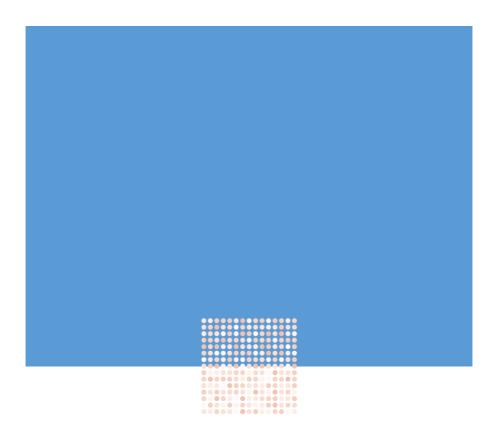
3. You have a topic, and you want to know if any articles have been published in this journal.
