HOW TO FIND JOURNALS


Start from the Databases page: https://library.glion.edu

If you are looking for a specific academic journal, we suggest you search on EBSCO Publication Finder:

- "Full Text Only" for all the articles with full text access
- "Academic (Peer Reviewed)
 Journals" if you want to search
 for academic resources
- "Catalog Only" for only the physical book in the library collection
- "Published Date" for selecting published document from the past 12 months, 5 years, 10 years, etc.

SEARCH IN EBSCO PUBLICATION FINDER

To know if the library holds a journal, go to the library website on the Databases tab and click on the database called "EBSCOhost Publication Finder":

Enter the name of the journal, e.g.:

The search result will display as follows:





The result shows in which database(s) you will be able to retrieve the full text.




Click on the database link to access the journal.

From this point you have 3 options:

1. You have a complete reference (e.g. Xingqin Qu, Xinwei Su, Huantao Chen, & Jie Yin. (2023). So you can simply browse through the year and issue numbers on the right-hand side, e.g. 2023, Volume 28, Issue 8:

2. You have the exact title, and you can simply use the "Search within this publication" link and enter the title:



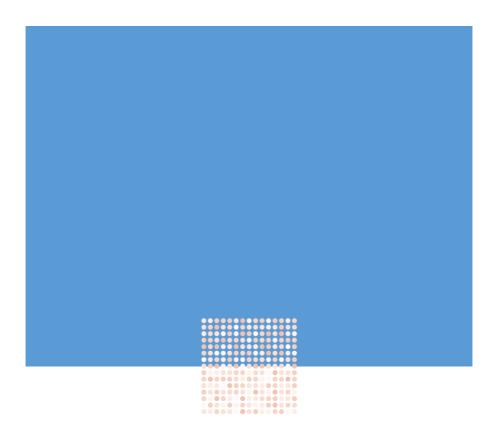
3. You have a topic, and you want to know if any articles have been published in this journal.
